Conflict of Interest Policy

Active and Senior Board Members, Associate Examiners and any other persons who have access to examination material or who have participated in the examination process must avoid conflicts of interest between other educational activities and the activities of the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery. Active Members are prohibited from participating in, endorsing or organizing a course, seminar, book or other activity which claims to be preparation for any examination offered by the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery. Participation in General Surgery preparation courses is allowed. Senior Members and Associate Examiners who wish to participate in such preparatory courses shall not be asked to participate in the Certifying Examinations of the Board. Participation in mock oral examinations is prohibited for Active Members of the Board at any time while they are examiners for the Board. Participation in mock oral examinations is prohibited for Senior Members until one year after completing service to the Board as examiners. Participation in mock oral examinations is prohibited for Associate Examiners from the time of acceptance as an examiner until one year following the completion of their term as an examiner. Any other persons who have access to examination material or who have participation in the examination process are not permitted to participate in any program or written material which claims to be preparation for a written examination offered by the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery.
